basmati rice (1kg and 5kg)
cooking oil (750ml and 1 litre)
dry chickpeas (1kg and 375g)
dry green lentils (1kg and 375g)
dry red lentils (1kg and 375g)
disposable shaving razors
NO baked beans or soup please
